



BUDGET SHEET INSTRUCTIONS

This Budget Sheet can be used to track a teams' Budgetbucks balance during each period of play. We recommend that each team have one 'laminated' Budget Sheet that can be re-used in each period of play (Note: Use dry erase markers). You can also display a larger version of the Budget Sheet and use in combination with the half page power up/sacrifice cards found on the Budgetball Website. We recommend that you apply Velcro or tape to the back of each card to help them stick to the Budget Sheet.

- 1 This is where you write the starting Budgetbucks balance for the period. A team's Budgetbucks balance carries over from period to period and game to game. In the first budget session in a single game or the first game of a tournament, the Budgetbucks balance is ZERO.
- 2 Add 10% interest [plus (+) or minus (-)] to your Budgetbucks Balance. Interest is rounded up or down.
- 3 Add Box 1 (starting Budgetbucks Balance) and Box 2 (Interest Calculated) and arrive at a total Budgetbucks balance for the next period of play. A team must also attempt to pay off at least half of their debt (if they have any) at the start of each Budget Session.
- 4 During a Budget Session, each team must select a combination of 3 power ups and/or sacrifices. You can write the power ups and sacrifices (and their values) in each box OR you can use in combination with the half page power up/sacrifice cards (found on the Budgetball Website).
- 5 Calculate the total value of all three power ups and sacrifices selected during the Budget Session and place in this box.
- 6 Calculate the total from Box 2 with the Total from Box 5 to arrive at the starting Budgetbucks balance that will placed in Box 1 for the next period of play.
- 7 Box 7a, 7b, and 7c are used to record the number of points (goals) scored on the field/court during period play.
- 8 Immediately following the last period of play in a single game or in the championship game of a tournament, a team will gain one additional point for every 5 Budgetbucks of surplus or lose one point for every 5 Budgetbucks of debt. The points earned or lost through Budgetbucks are added to or subtracted from the points scored by the team during play on the court. This line should be used to record the number of points gained/lost
- 9 The Current Score is where you record the cumulative score for the entire game. Following Step 8, recalculate the current score—to determine the winner of the Game.
