How to Use the Budgetball Quick Budget Sheet

Print out one quick budget sheet per team for each Budgetball game you plan to play. For example, if two teams are going to play two games, you'll need four copies of the "quick budget sheet".

During the first Budget Session:

- Teams start their VERY FIRST Budget Session with Zero Budgetbucks.
- Record the three Power-Ups and/or Sacrifices on the "PU/S" line
- Record the number of Budgetbucks earned or borrowed for each Power-Up or Sacrifice on the corresponding line labeled "BB".
- Record the sum of the Budgetbucks earned and borrowed (remember that some are positive and some are negative) on the line labeled "Net BB Session 1".

**Note: During a tournament, the Budgetbucks balance from the previous game-is carried over into the first Budget Session, therefore, the directions outlined below for second and third Budget Sessions apply.*

After the first period of play:

- Record the number of goals (points) scored by your team in the circle labeled "Score".

During the second and third Budget Sessions:

- Calculate 10% interest on your "Net BB" from the previous session, and record this on the line labeled "10% Interest BB". Always round up or down, as appropriate; record your Budgetbucks balance as a whole number.
- Add the 10% Interest to your previous "Net BB" balance and record your starting balance on the line labeled "New BB Balance".
- Select your Power-Ups and Sacrifices for the upcoming period of play and record the Budgetbucks earned or borrowed as you did during the first Budget Session.

Remember: If you have a negative Budgetbucks balance (debt), first you **MUST** take Sacrifices equal to half your debt.

- Add the number you recorded as "New BB Balance" to the Budgetbuck values of the new Power-Ups and Sacrifices you chose, then record the total on the line labeled "Net BB Session 2/3"

After the second and third periods of play:

- At the end of each period, update your cumulative score for total points scored so far in the game in the "Score" circle next to the period just completed.

To calculate your team's final score:

- Transfer the number on the line labeled "Net BB Session 3" to the line right before BB at the bottom of the quick budget sheet.
- Divide that number by 5 and write the answer on the line before the word "POINTS". Always round down – so if you have 2 BBs and divide by 5, the number of POINTS is 0.
- Add the number of POINTS to the number in the "Score" circle from Period 3, and record that sum in the "FINAL SCORE" circle.
